The Dixons - Visiting this Sunday!

Bradley and Cleria Dixon currently live in Fort Worth, Texas with their two children Jeremiah (age 7) and Isaiah (age 4). Bradley and Cleria both graduated from Lubbock Christian University with Bachelor's Degrees in Social Work. Bradley went on to obtain his Master's degree in Social Work from the University of Texas in Arlington, Texas. Cleria pursued her love for people and service through her work as a Refugee Case Manager with refugees relocated to the DFW area. Bradley is a licensed Master Social Worker and desires to see people's lives transformed.

Bradley and Cleria felt called to missions early in their life and bonded around their love for God and desire to further his kingdom in the world. Bradley and Cleria have prayed that God would reveal to them their role in His mission. After learning about the refugee crisis in the Middle East they began praying for the displaced people in these regions. Cleria and Bradley immediately felt a connection with these displaced people through Cleria's own experience as an asylum. Cleria, along with her family, fled to the United States from Burundi, Africa in 2001 after civil war and political turmoil tore apart her country. The Dixon's were made aware of a need for disciple makers among Muslim refugees in Athens, Greece. They have answered the call and are ready to engage in God's pursuit of the displaced people in Athens and beyond.
