Carpenter's Kitchen Offering



When Broadway began Carpenter's Kitchen 33 years ago we formed a partnership with the South Plains Food Bank to supply much of the food. They collected left over food from local restaurants and delivered it for us to heat up and serve. This was called the Second Helpings

Program. They also supplied us with vegetables, fruit, and other staple items at a nominal cost. The South Plains Food Bank is no longer able to supply us with food. This is due in part to restaurants no longer donating leftover food and to the changes in policy regarding supply of USDA food to churches. The bottom line is that we must purchase most of the food that we serve at Carpenter's Kitchen. In light of this, the Elders have decided to make our October special collection an additional funding source for Carpenter's Kitchen to allow us to serve highly nutritional and high quality food each week. The money we collect in October will allow us to produce these high quality meals for those who

otherwise might go hungry. We ask each of you to consider donating the money you would spend on one meal to help feed others for fifty-two weeks this year. We have served an average of more than 200 meals each Sunday for all of 2018. We ask you to



prayerfully consider sacrificially serving hungry people in our community. By giving, this funding will enable us to continue to provide quality meals each Sunday.
