*St. John Leading Home His Adopted Mother (c. 1850), Tate Gallery, London, by William Dyce*  
This Scottish painter is associated with the Pre-Raphaelite Brotherhood, who took their themes from literature and painted them naturalistically (they are active the same time as the French Impressionists). In this scene, Mary and John are departing the tomb (after Christ's burial but before his resurrection, presumably). John's concern for his adopted mother is apparent in his expression and his body language as he gently guides Mary away from her son's burial site.
